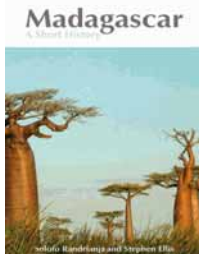

As a boy soldier with the Partisans he experienced the horrors of warfare, from which he barely survived.

More than any other action, the Brusilov Offensive brought the Habsburg Empire to the brink of a separate peace, while creating conditions for revolution within the Russian Imperial Army. Timothy C.
