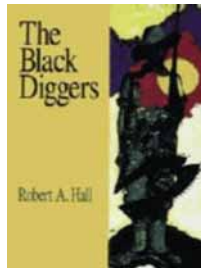
Thousands of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people served their country during the Second World War and this book focuses on the experiences of six. Oodgeroo Noonuccal was a wireless operator whose brothers were prisoners of war. Reg Saunders served in Greece and New Guinea, as the first Aboriginal officer in the Australian Army, and later in Korea. Leonard Waters trained and served as the first Aboriginal fighter pilot. Charles Mene, a Torres Strait Islander, served throughout the war and was awarded the Military Medal in the Korean War. Saulo Waia, a pearl fisher, defended the Strait with fellow soldiers while non-indigenous people were evacuated. Other Islanders like Tom Lowah gave years of service and received lower pay than white servicemen.

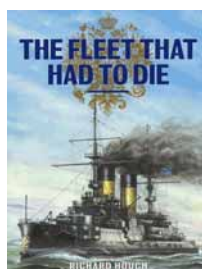
SHALLOW GRAVES IN SIBERIA:
MICHAEL KRUPA

The suffering inflicted on millions in Stalin's camps has been told before - but Michael Krupa's story is unique. He retells his gruelling and traumatic experiences with clarity, honesty and courage. Michael Krupa was born into a poor family in south-west Poland, and in his teens was accepted into a Jesuit seminary. He ran away before taking his final vows and joined the army. Soon afterwards, the German tanks rolled into Poland and easily defeated her antiquated forces - the Polish cavalry were armed with sabres. Krupa survived Hitler's invasion, but was arrested in Soviet-occupied eastern Poland and accused of spying. After enduring torture in Moscow's notorious Lubyanka prison, he was sentenced to ten years' corrective labour and deported to the Pechora Gulag. Most prisoners there were worked and starved to death within a year. But Krupa managed again to escape, and in the chaos following the Nazi invasion of the Soviet Union made one of the most extraordinary journeys of the war - from Siberia to safety in Afghanistan. Krupa's Jesuit training had given him an inner strength and resilience which enabled him to survive in the face of appalling brutality and cruelty. Luck and the kindness of strangers helped him complete his epic journey to freedom.

The Battle of Leyte Gulf was an extremely unusual battle. It was unusual in five ways that are so obvious they are often overlooked: 1. it was a series of actions, not a single battle; 2. it was fought over five days (historically, naval battles have seldom spread themselves over more than one or two days); 3. its name refers to a series of related actions subsequently grouped together, none of which were fought inside Leyte Gulf; 4. it was a full-scale fleet action fought after the issue of victory and defeat at sea had been decided; and finally, it resulted in clear, overwhelming victory and defeat.
